### Day 01 – 24 April: Departure to Algier, Algeria

Departure from KLIA at 9:50am. Transit 4:00 hours in Istanbul. Arrival Algiers airport at 9:25pm. Transfer to hotel for rest. Overnight in Algier.

### Day 02 – 25 April: Algier Full Day City Tour (B)

After breakfast, full day city tour in Algier city. Walking tour to visit the Casbah, Old City, architectural tour of downtown. Overnight in Algier.

### **Day 03 – 26 April: Algier – Constantine (B)**

After breakfast, drive 3 hours to visit Djemila Roman Ruins. Djemila became a UNESCO World Heritage Site for its unique adaptation of Roman architecture to a mountain environment. Significant buildings in ancient Cuicul include a theatre, temples, basilicas, arches, streets, and houses. The exceptionally well-preserved ruins surround a large, paved square with an entry marked by a majestic arch. Then continue driving 1.5 hours onward to Constantine. Overnight in Constantine.



### **Day 04 – 27 April: Constantine Half Day Tour – Fly to Ghardaia (B)**

After breakfast, half day tour in Constantine. Later move to airport to catch **domestic flight to Ghardaia ETD 1:20pm**. Transfer to hotel in Ghardaia. Overnight in Ghardaia.

### **Day 05 – 28 April: Ghardaia Full Day Tour (B)**

After breakfast, full day tour of Ghardaia in MZab Valley. Ghardaia listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Founded in the 11th century, it was built around the cave reputedly inhabited by the female saint. Ghardaia is a fortified town with white and red clay houses that rise in terraces and arcades toward the pyramid-style mosque at its centre. Between dunes, oasis and ancestral craftsmanship, it offers a journey back in time. Overnight in Ghardaia.

### **Day 06 – 29 April: Mzab Valley (B)**

After breakfast, continuation of the Mzab Valley tour. Tucked away in the heart of the northern Sahara, the Mzab Valley is one of Algeria's most fascinating yet underappreciated gems. Recognized by UNESCO in 1982 as a World Heritage Site. Mzab is not just a place, it's a living testament to resilient architecture, spiritual harmony, and community centered urban design. Overnight in Ghardaia.

### **Day 07 – 30 April: Fly to Algier – Day Trip Tipaza & Cherchell (B)**

After early breakfast, domestic flight to Algier ETD 9:15am. Drive 80km to visit Tipaza and then Cherchell Roman Ruins. This UNESCO World Heritage Site is arguably one of the most stunning Roman archaeological complexes in the Mediterranean. Evening return to Algier. Overnight in Algier.

### **Day 08 – 1 May: Fly to Tunis, Tunisia (B)**

After breakfast, it's a free and easy day. After lunch catch flight to Tunis. Overnight in Tunis.

### **Day 09 – 2 May: Kairouan - Tozeur (B, L, D)**

After breakfast, drive to Kairouan 150km from Tunis. Visit of the Great Mosque of Oqba Ibn Nafi, the Sidi Sahbi Mausoleum and walk through the serpentine streets of the local medina, pass the souqs and get a tasty sample of makroudh (a traditional local pastry stuffed with dates) and learn about the traditional trade of local women rug making. After lunch, continue drive 260km to Tozeur. Overnight in Tozeur.

### **Day 10 – 3 May: Tozeur – Douz (B, L, D)**

After breakfast, drive to visit the big mountain oasis of Chebika, waterfalls of Tamerza. Continue to visit Star Wars desert set. Afternoon, departure to Douz with a stop at the Chott el Djerid (Salt Lake). The adventure starts with an amazing view changing from lands of green palms to dunes of golden sand. You can explore the sand dune with a camel ride and / or quad (extra fees). Overnight in Douz.



### **Day 11 – 4 May: Douz – Matmata – El Jem – Sousse (B, L, D)**

After breakfast, drive to Matmata. The Berber town to discover its fascinating troglodyte houses—man-made caves dug out of large pits in the ground. Stop to visit one of them into the home by the family who lives there. Then drive to El Jem. Afternoon, visit of the third-largest ancient Roman amphitheatre in the world and visit to a handcrafts centre to learn about mosaics. Then drive to Sousse. Overnight in Sousse.

**Day 12 – 5 May: Sousse – Tunis (B, L, D)**

After breakfast, drive back to Tunis. Explore Tunisia's bustling capital. Tunis was one of the greatest cities in the world during the reign of the Almohad and Hafsid dynasties from the twelfth to the 16th centuries. Today, it boasts a diversity of distinct cultures and a rich, complex history shaped by ages of colonization. Experience this diversity and venture to the city's medina to witness hundreds of palaces, mosques and fountains. Afternoon, visit of the National Bardo Museum, a jewel of Tunisian heritage. It is housed in an old Beylic palace dating back to the XIXth Century. Overnight in Tunis.

**Day 13 – 6 May: Tunis (B, L, D)**

After breakfast, visit the archaeological site of Carthage (UNESCO Heritage since 1979). Then drive to Sidi Bou Said, an incredibly charming town, paint in white and blue. Overnight in Tunis.

**Day 14 – 7 May: Departure to Kuala Lumpur (B)**

After early breakfast, move to airport to catch flight departure at 9:45am. Transit 2 hours in Istanbul. Arrival in Kuala Lumpur at 8:10am next day. End tour.
