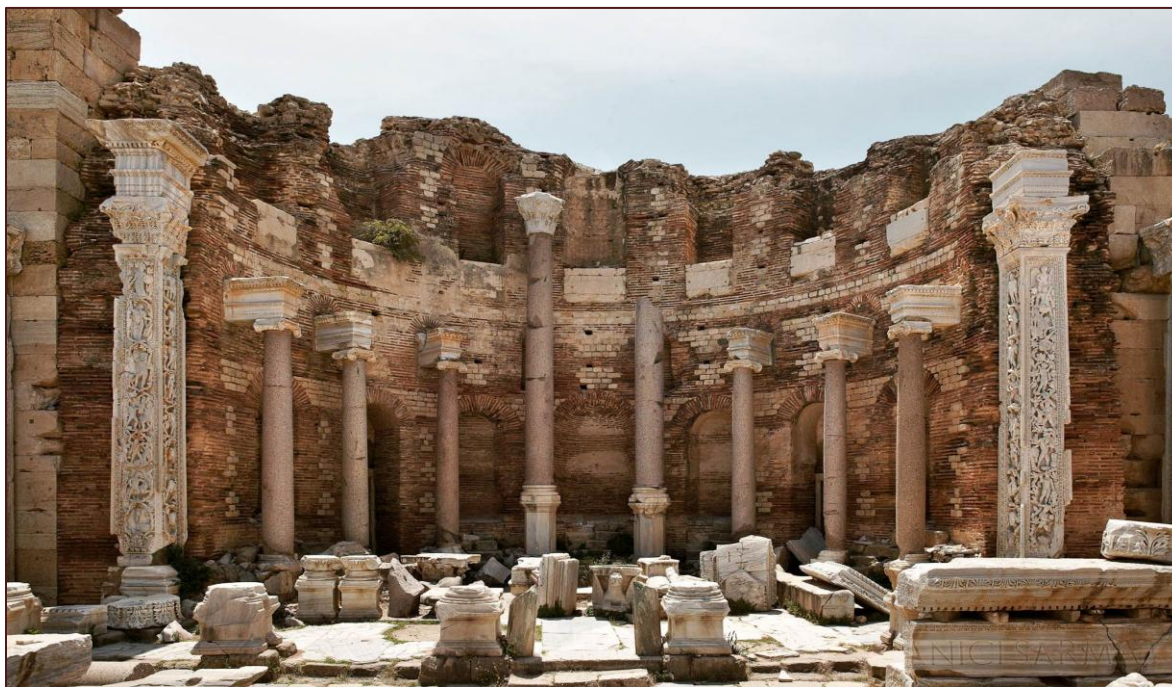
Tour Itinerary

Day 01 – 19 Nov: Departure Kuala Lumpur to Tripoli, Libya

Departure from KLIA 11:45pm. Transit in Istanbul 3:15 hours.

Day 02 – 20 Nov: Arrival Tripoli – Half Day Sightseeing (L, D)

Arrival Mitiga International Airport, Tripoli Libya at 11:25am. After lunch, visit the Red Castle (Qasr Al Jarahim), a historical fortress that houses the National Museum. Explore the bustling Souk Al Jum'ah (Market of Friday). Stroll along Martyr's Square and enjoy dinner at one of the local restaurants. Overnight in Tripoli.

Day 03 – 21 Nov: Day Trip Leptis Magna (B, L, D)

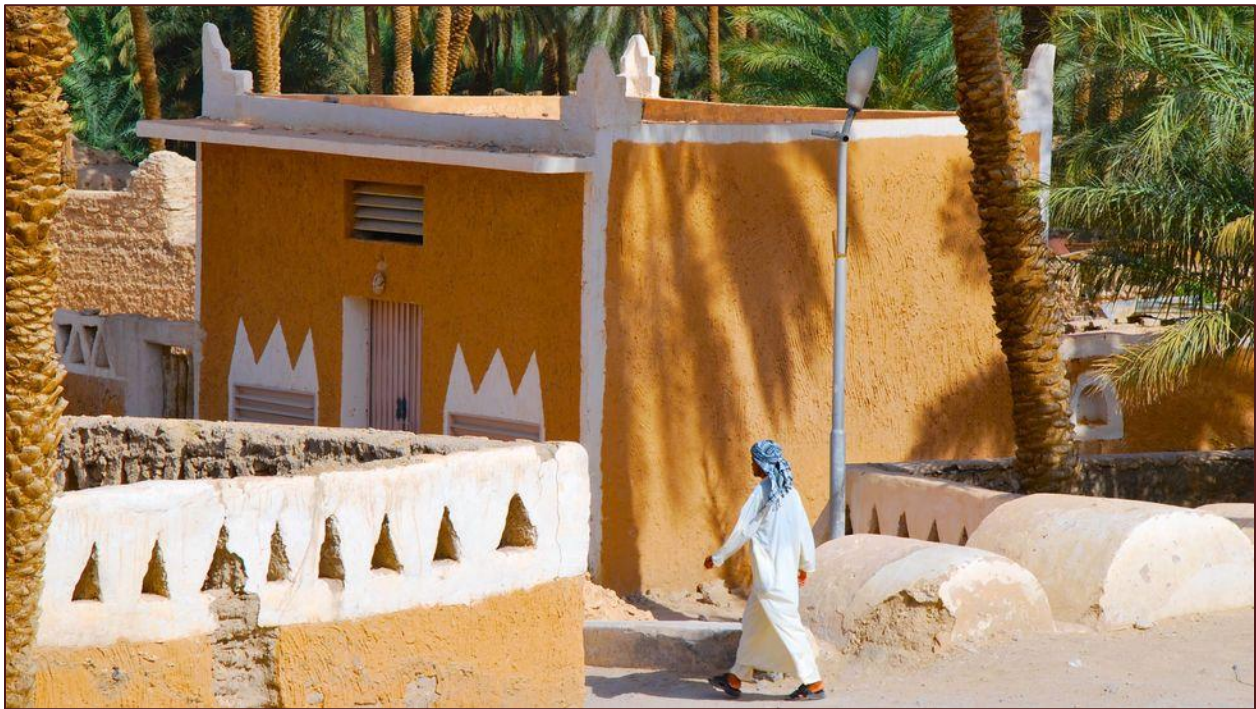
Morning after breakfast depart for Leptis Magna, another UNESCO World Heritage Site with impressive Roman ruins, approximately 120km from Tripoli. Explore the ruins, including the Theatre, Forum, and Capitoline Temple. Evening return to Tripoli. Overnight in Tripoli.

Day 04 – 22 Nov: Tripoli - Ghadames (B, L, D)

Morning after breakfast depart for Ghadames, a beautiful oasis town located in western Libya. The journey takes around 8 hours by road. Will break the journey by visiting several highlights along the way. Visit Qasr al-Hajj one of the finest examples of Berber architecture, a giant granary from the 12th century a visit to an ancient village of Tamzin. Overnight in Ghadames.

Day 05 – 23 Nov: Ghadames (B, L, D)

Morning after breakfast, visit the Old City of Ghadames, a UNESCO World Heritage site, a giant Saharian city composed of hundreds of entangled lanes, packed with mosques and historical houses. Will finish day with a visit to desert. Overnight in Ghadames.



Day 06 – 24 Nov: Ghadames - Tripoli (B, L, D)

Morning after breakfast, return to Tripoli with a stop in Nalut. Overnight in Tripoli.

Day 07 – 25 Nov: Day Trip Sabratha (B, L, D)

Morning after breakfast, depart for Sabratha, a UNESCO World Heritage Site with Roman ruins, approximately 60km west of Tripoli. Explore ancient Roman cities, including the Capitoline Temple and Theatre. Evening return to Tripoli. Overnight in Tripoli.



Day 08 – 26 Nov: Half Day Tripoli - Departure Tripoli to Kuala Lumpur (B, L)

Morning after breakfast, half day free and easy to explore local bazaar, to buy souvenirs to bring back home or just simply explore the lively Old City. After lunch, move to airport to catch up flight departure at 8pm. Transit in Istanbul 1:30 hours.

Day 09 – 27 Nov: Arrival Kuala Lumpur

Arrival Kuala Lumpur at 5:20pm. End tour.

Hardship Level

Refund/ Cancellation Policy

Tour deposit

A deposit must be paid as a reservation fee. The balance of full payment must be made within 21 days before the trip. A failure to comply with this requirement may result in the cancellation of reservation and forfeiture of deposit.

Cancellation by guest

22-44 working days before the date of departure - forfeiture of tour deposit

15-21 working days before the date of departure - 35% of tour fare

08-14 working days before the date of departure - 50% of tour fare

03-07 working days before the date of departure - 75% of tour fare

02 working days or less before the date of departure - 100% of tour fare
