Tour Itinerary

Day 01 – 22 Dec: Arrival Karachi, Pakistan (D)

Departure from KLIA 5:00pm. Arrival Karachi's Jinnah International Airport at 8:10pm (local time). Check in to hotel. Then, you'll have your first taste of local Pakistani dining. Overnight Beach Luxury Hotel, Karachi.



Day 02 – 23 Dec: Karachi – Kund Malir, Balochistan (236km, 4-5 hours) (B, D)

After breakfast, check out and drive to Balochistan. Be one of the first foreigners in the world to go dolphin watching and explore the mangroves by boat in Damb. In the afternoon drive to Kund Malir and check in to Gold Coast Resort on the beach. Dinner at the resort by the best chef in the region. Overnight Gold Coast Resort.

Day 03 – 24 Dec: Hingol National Park (B, D)

Morning after breakfast, head out early to beat the heat on our climb to the top of the Chandragup Mud Volcano (about 20 minutes climb). Then kick off your shoes for a walk in the Arabian Sea at Sapat Beach/Tanak Koh Beach. Group dinner at the resort. Overnight Gold Coast Resort.



Day 04 – 25 Dec: Hingol National Park – Gwadar (386km, 5-6 hours) (B, D)

Morning after breakfast, check out of Gold Coast Resort. It's a day full of gorgeous beaches, vistas and unique natural beauty. Take in the famous Golden Beach, Princess of Hope, and

Sphinx of Balochistan. In the evening check in at Pearl-Continental Hotel Gwadar. Group dinner in the hotel. Overnight Pearl-Continental Hotel, Gwadar.

Day 05 – 26 Dec: Gwadar (B, D)

Morning after breakfast, we will visit around Gwadar. This coastal town is stunning! We'll start with a bit of local life at the Bazaar in Gwadar, visit Omani Fort, sip chai at a local fisherman's village, and enjoy lunch on the beach at Koh-e-Mehdi, which looks like another planet. Evening free time. (Visit Hammerhead Viewpoint if weather and time permit). Overnight Pearl-Continental Hotel, Gwadar.



Day 06 – 27 Dec: Jiwani Daytrip (84km from Gwadar) (B, D)

The west edge of the region is remote and breathtaking. We'll travel in 4WD trucks on this day to visit Ganz village and beach, Victoria Hut (built for Queen Victoria), and the abandoned WWII Airstrip that is off limits to most visitors to the region. Sunset dinner on the beach or at the hotel. Overnight Pearl-Continental Hotel, Gwadar.

Day 07 – 28 Dec: Gwadar – Kund Malir (386km, 5-6 hours) (B, D)

Morning after breakfast, early check out of Pearl-Continental Hotel Gwadar. This is one of our two longer travel days. Picnic lunch or lunch at a local dhaba (fresh food prepared in the local style). Overnight Gold Coast Resort, Kund Malir.



Day 08 – 29 Dec: Kund Malir – Karachi (236km, 4-5 hours) (B)

Morning after breakfast, continue drive to Karachi. Drop off at the airport to catch up flight to Kuala Lumpur in the evening departure 9:10pm. (If time permits, we will stop by at the local bazaar in Karachi to buy souvenir to bring home before moving to airport).

Day 09 – 30 Dec: Arrival Kuala Lumpur

Arrival in Kuala Lumpur at 6:25am. End tour.

Hardship Level

Refund/ Cancellation Policy

Tour deposit

A deposit must be paid as a reservation fee. The balance of full payment must be made within 21 days before the trip. A failure to comply with this requirement may result in the cancellation of reservation and forfeiture of deposit.

Cancellation by guest

22-44 working days before the date of departure - forfeiture of tour deposit

15-21 working days before the date of departure - 35% of tour fare

08-14 working days before the date of departure - 50% of tour fare

Cancellation by company
