Tour Itinerary

Day 01 – 18 Jan: Arrival Asmara, Eritrea (2325 metres above sea level)

Departure KLIA at 10:15am. Arrival at Asmara International Airport at 10:10pm local time, guests will be warmly welcomed by local guide transfer to hotel. Overnight in Asmara.



Day 02 – 19 Jan: Asmara Sightseeing (B, L, D)

After breakfast, enjoy a comprehensive exploration of Asmara, recognized by UNESCO as one of the world's finest examples of modernist urban planning and architecture. Visits include, Fiat Tagliero Service Station, Cinema Impero, Cinema Roma, St. Joseph's Cathedral, Enda Mariam

Orthodox Cathedral, Al Khulafa Al Rashiudin Mosque, National Museum of Eritrea, Medeber Recycling Market, Traditional Market, Railway Station, Historic Italian Quarter, Asmara Theatre, Historic Cafes. Experience cultural traditional Eritrean coffee ceremony. Overnight in Asmara.

Day 03 – 20 Jan: Asmara – Keren (1590 metres above sea level) (B, L, D)

After breakfast, depart for Keren 93km. Keren known as Eritrea's vibrant cultural center. Visits include, Keren Town Centre, Traditional Markets, Mariam Dearit Baobab Church, Italian War Cemetery, British Commonwealth Cemetery, Traditional Bilen Communities, Traditional Tigre Communities. Experience cultural Eritrean coffee ceremony, traditional music and dance. Overnight in Keren.



Day 04 – 21 Jan: Keren – Massawa (B, L, D)

After breakfast, travel from the Eritrean highlands to the Red Sea coast, around 3 hours' drive. The route offers one of Africa's most spectacular scenic drives as the road descends from over 2325 meters above sea level to the coast. On the way, scenic stops at Nefasit, Ghindae, Gahtelay and mountain viewpoints. Afternoon, sightseeing in Massawa. Visits include, Historic Old Town, Ottoman Architecture, Via Roma, Port Area, Coral Stone Buildings, Historic Waterfront and Imperial Palace Area. Evening enjoy sunset overlooking the Red Sea. Overnight in Massawa.

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Day 05 – 22 Jan: Green Island – Asmara (B, L, D)

After breakfast, board a private boat 20 minutes excursion to Green Island. Explore the island, swimming, snorkeling, and beach relaxation. Return to Massawa for further sightseeing. Visit Red Sea Museum, Sahaba Mosque, Sheikh Hanafi Mosque, Historic City Centre and Local Fish Market. Late afternoons drive back to Asmara. Depending on time, evening stroll through Harnet Avenue. Traditional Eritrean dinner. Overnight in Asmara.

Day 06 – 23 Jan: Asmara – Fly to Djibouti (B, L, D)

After leisure breakfast, enjoy free time for shopping and independent exploration. Visit local handicraft shopping and traditional market for café experience and photography walk. After dinner, transfer to Asmara International Airport departs at 11pm. Overnight in Dubai Airport.



Day 7 - 24 Jan: Welcome to Djibouti (D)

Arrival at Djibouti Ambouli International Airport at 2pm. Transfer to hotel for check-in. Rest of the day leisure, free and easy and dinner. Overnight in Djibouti *L'Europe Hotel*

Day 8 – 25 Jan: Djibouti – Lake Abbe (B, L, D)

After breakfast, beginning your scenic journey to the spectacular Lake Abbé.

Discover one of East Africa's most extraordinary landscapes, famous for its towering limestone chimneys, geothermal activity, and breathtaking sunset views that create an unforgettable desert experience. Overnight in Lake Abbe *Lake Abbé Camp*



Day 9 – 26 Jan: Lake Abbe – Lake Assal – Ardoukoba Volcano – Day Forest National Park (B, L, D)

Begin the day with a scenic drive to Lake Assal, Africa's lowest point and one of the saltiest lakes on Earth. Continue to the impressive Ardoukoba Volcano, where you will witness remarkable volcanic formations before heading into the refreshing highlands of Day Forest National Park, home to rare wildlife, ancient juniper forests, and spectacular mountain scenery. Overnight in Day Forest National Park *Day Forest Lodge*

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Day 10 – 27 Jan: Day Forest National Park – Djibouti (B, L, D)

After breakfast, enjoy a final visit to the beautiful Day Forest National Park, taking in panoramic viewpoints and the park's unique biodiversity. Later, return to Djibouti City 2-3 hours' drive. After check-in, enjoy a guided tour of Djibouti City and exploring its vibrant markets, historic neighborhoods, lively waterfront, and cultural landmarks while discovering the rich heritage of the Republic of Djibouti. Overnight in Djibouti *L'Europe Hotel*
